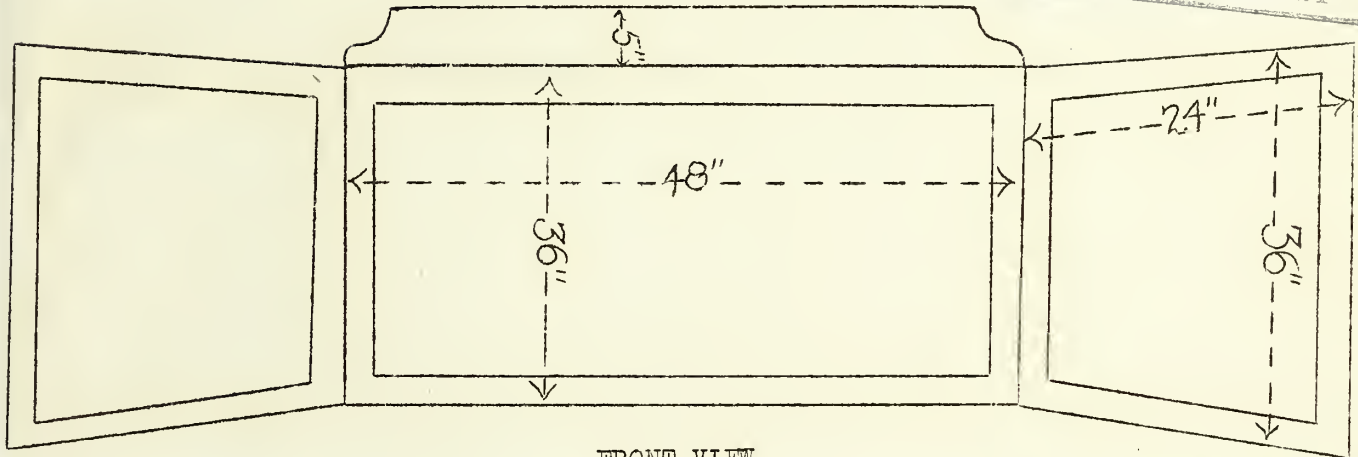

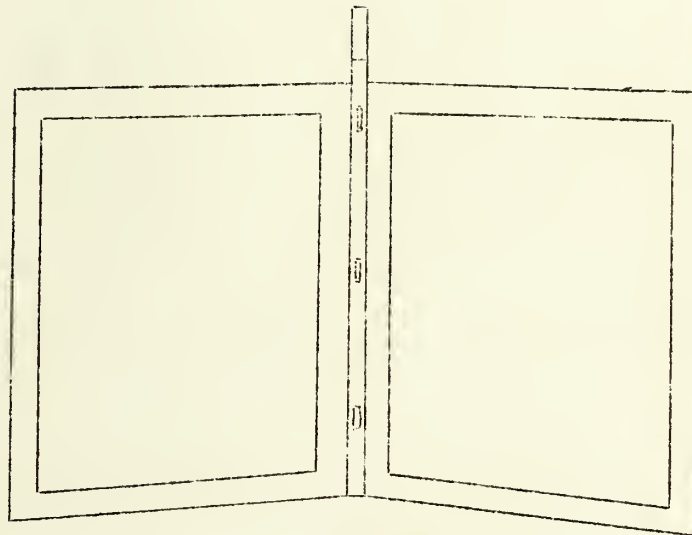

The frame work is made of 7/8" material, 2 1/2" wide. The four wing panels are fastened to the center panel with double action cabinet hinges. Compo or beaver board is used for paneling. The panels are held in place by moulding screwed to the framework on all four sides of each panel. The moulding is screwed so as to allow the panels to be easily changed.

The packing case is equipped with four folding legs so that it may be used as a base for the exhibit. The burlap cover clips over the entire table and forms a neat appearing, portable display fixture.
