GERMAN IRISES

German irises should be planted shallow, and should be given, as nearly as possible, a dry, well-drained location in full sun. A dressing of some form of lime or limestone is very beneficial.

Kochii, Amas, and Germanica Alba are early. Germanica Alba and Innocenza are white, Amas is rich purple, Kochii very dark purple. Pallida Dalmatica is pale blue, Ciengialti light blue, Gertrude blue, and Argus dark blue. Koenig is smoky yellow and rich brown, a superb variety.

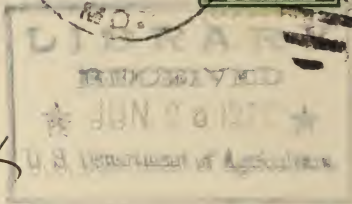
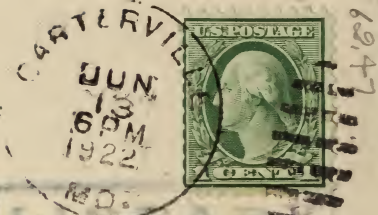
Pallida Dalmatica and Koenig, 25c each, \$2.50 per dozen. Ciengialti, Amas, and Innocenza, 20c each, \$2.00 per dozen. Gertrude, Argus, Kochii, and Germanica Alba, 15c each, \$1.50 per dozen. One each of any five, \$1.00. One each of the nine, \$1.50; six each, \$8.00; twelve each, \$15.00. A few plants of the famous Black Knight, 50c per division; Pfauenauge, yellow and purple, 25c.
