Australian and New Zealand originations: Canberra. Hinemoa, Milkmaid, Mrs. S. A. Errey, Mrs. T. Rattray and Red Lory

From other originaturs come Frederick Christ. similar to Coryphee but without the weakness of that varicts. Fred Christ was introduced at $\$ 300$ per bulb and is one of the few high-priced Glads in which I was not disappointed. Picardy- - that great Glad from Canada. Everyone should have it. Order early as some growers report large bulbs already sold. The only fault is its too rapid increase. Ruffled Gold, the yellow that stands the heat. One cut flower grower reports the florists have this selected before he can get out of the truck.
