ARGENTINE INTERNATIONAL TRADE

1913

The Argentine commercial intercourse with foreign nations has attained in the last twenty years a very great development drawing universal attention to its prosperity. In the last decade 1904-13, it shows an increase of 108⁵ %.

The total value of imports & exports in 1913 reaches 904.857.089 \$ gold (or say £ 179.535.136) but adding to this figure, the ingress & egress of gold, which in a great exporting country like Argentina takes a prominent part to cover the balance of the trade, the amount reaches then 996.215.998 \$ (say £ 197.661.904).

Now if this sum is divided by 7.731.257 calculated to be the population of the Republic it returns an average of 129 \$ gold (£ 25-11-10) per inhabitant, a figure that very few countries in the world have attained.

The commercial advance made in the ten years (1904-1913) by the principal South American Republics shows the following proportions:

Looking now into the development of our foreign commerce during the half century the growth of each decade over the former one, may be seen in the following table.

Thus the increase of the last period appears to be not only the larger one by the bulk of the trade, a remarkable feature in a new country growing at the rate of ours but also by the coefficient of its accretion compared with the previous periods,

The customs revenue of the Republic follows logically the advance of its commerce and the figures comprising the three principal headings thus prove it.

The augmentation in this source of revenue is therefore, in the ten years, equal to gold \$ 51,890,902 or say 110 % notwithstanding the abrogation made in 1906 of the export duties formerly charged upon animal products, which represented annually about 2 1/2 millions of dollars.

The wealth and prosperity of our foreign trade may be therefore fairly appreciated without further comment.

According to the Banks & Insurance Census taken by this Office in 30th June 1913, there existed in the country 143 banks of different kinds of which 118 were national and 25 foreign.

The capital of all amounted to 772.960.122 \$_n (*) (say £ 67.483.859) and m'_n \$ 482.572.975 say £ 42.131.393 in mortgage bonds (cedulas) issued by the National Mortgage Bank.

The total deposits were \$ 1.841.154.991 m'_n (£ 160.743.407) including \$ 455.745.796 m'_n savings banks deposits.

Bills discounted and accounts current summed \$ m'_n 1.591.450.905 (£ 138.942.806) plus \$ 1.022.740.125 loans on property and other securities. In total (£ 288.233.894).

Our commerce with foreign countries is also worthy of mention, especially with the English market which is, without doubt, the most valuable to us owing to its liberal policy which offers a free port to all our productions.

The data given below shows that Argentina is the country which has more largely provided the British market with cereals and meat in 1913, with a value of 34½ millions £ out of a total of 92,3 millions, that is to say, almost a proportion of 37½ %.

English statistics also show in eloquent figures the incentive offered by our country for the employment of foreign capital, and of this, full details may be found in the subjoined table. Argentina appears in the first place amongst the countries to which the issued capital was destined in the first half year 1914, and ranks third including the British possessions; that is to say, 38,770,600 £ went to Canada, 18,796,200 £ to Australasia, and 12,809,200 £ to Argentina. This attraction of our market for the employment of foreign capital is not a rare feature, and has been increasing for some years.

Argentina receives 36,2 % of the total exports and is the principal market for most of the american manufactures.

According to Argentine commercial statistics, the goods imported in 1913 from the United States of America were valued at \$ gold 62.032.853 of which \$ gold 22.135.215 were received duty free. — (see page 42).

Amongst the principal items of our wealth stands forth the meat trade transformed during the last quarter of a century by the advance and energy of the country, the improving of its stock, and the change of the primitive methods of treating the meat which constituted the traditional system of three centuries, (jerked beef, etc.), into the freezing and preserving of the meats of the finest quality, by the most perfect methods, and into the nutritious extracts and other products, which are the result of improved industry and latest progress. The growth of this branch of our activity is also extraordinary and is fully shown by the following figures.

In 1885, the year in which the frozen meat system first commenced, all the exports of meat in its various forms, reached a total of \$ gold 6.684.945, whereas in 1913 it increased to \$ gold 53.486.761, that is to say, almost nine times the value of the annual sales 29 years before. In the course of these

29 years the Argentine Republic has sold meat to foreign countries to a value of 617,989,860 \$ gold, this enormous sum corresponding to an annual average of 21,309,995 \$ gold. Since the year 1900 the trade has been progressively higher, and in the last few years, the yearly increases have varied from 4 to 10 millions \$ gold.

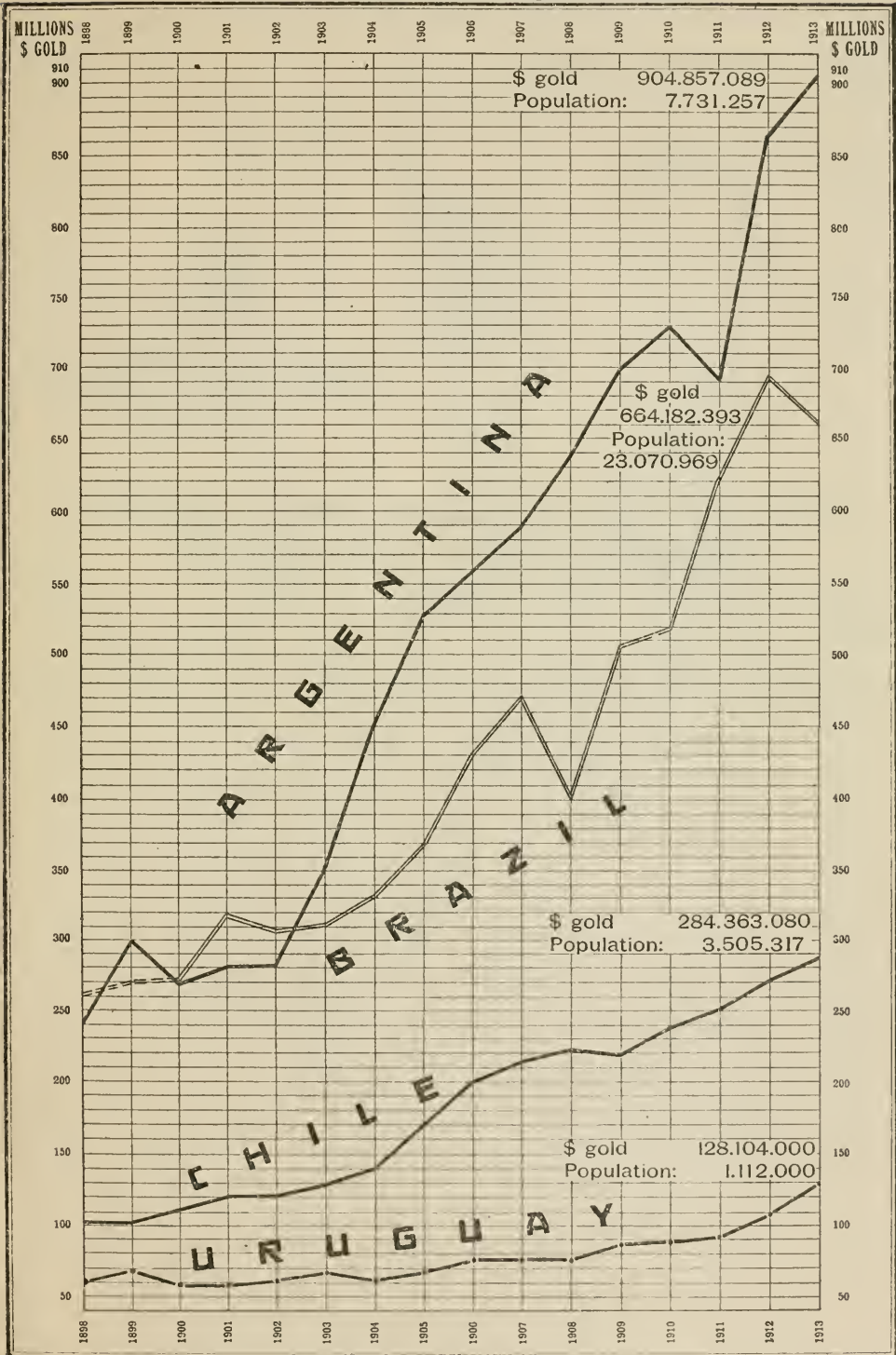

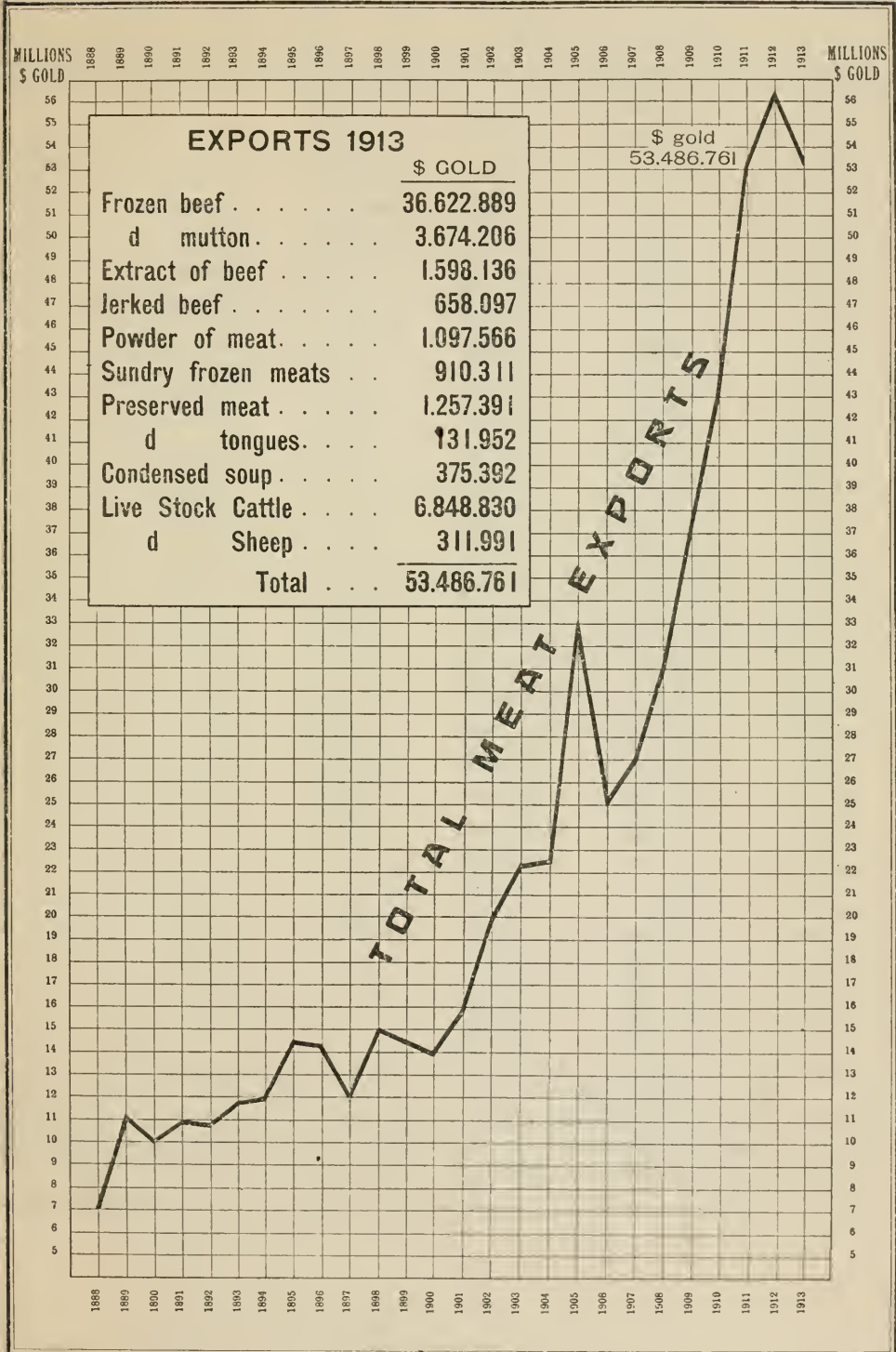

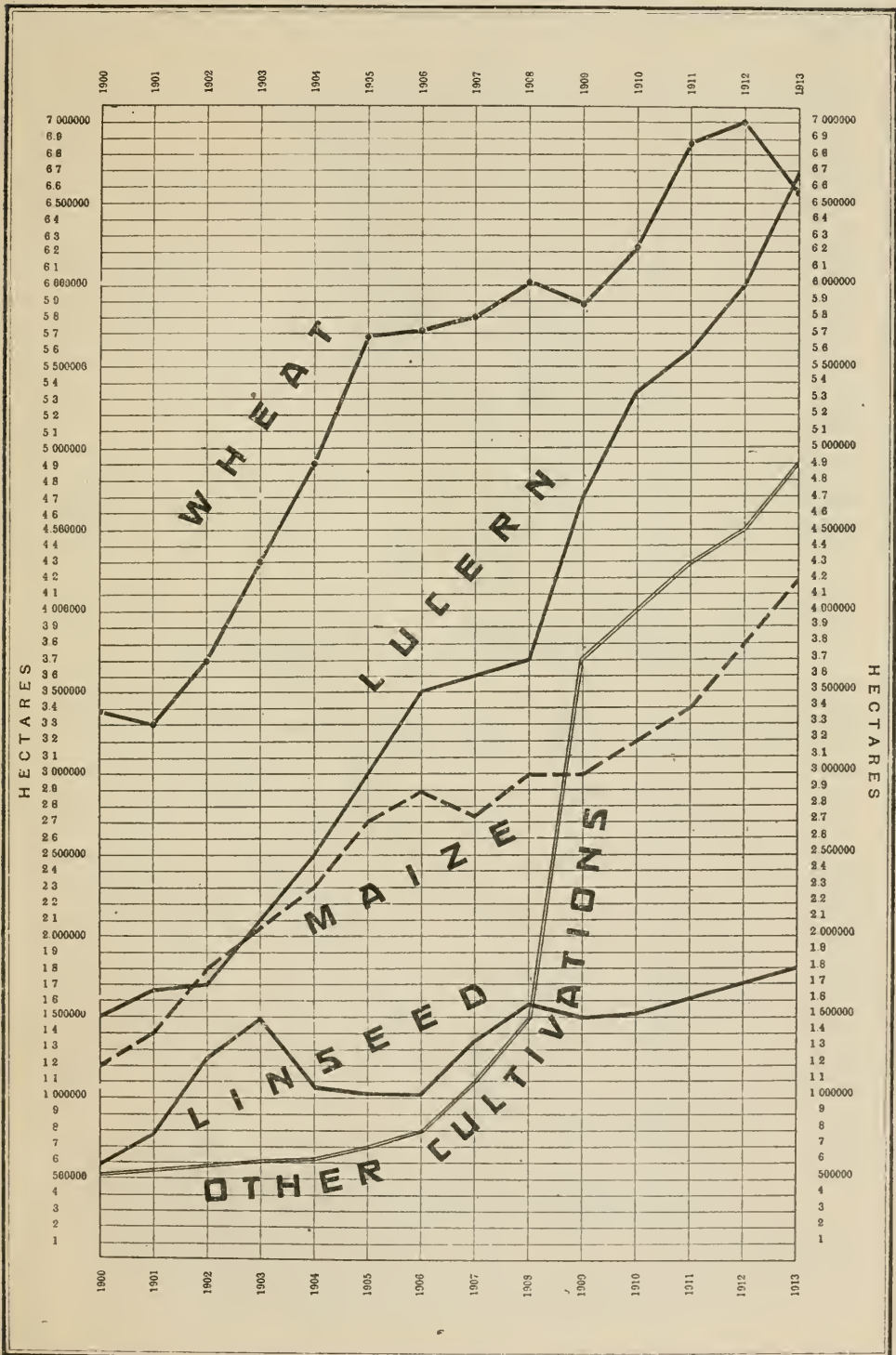

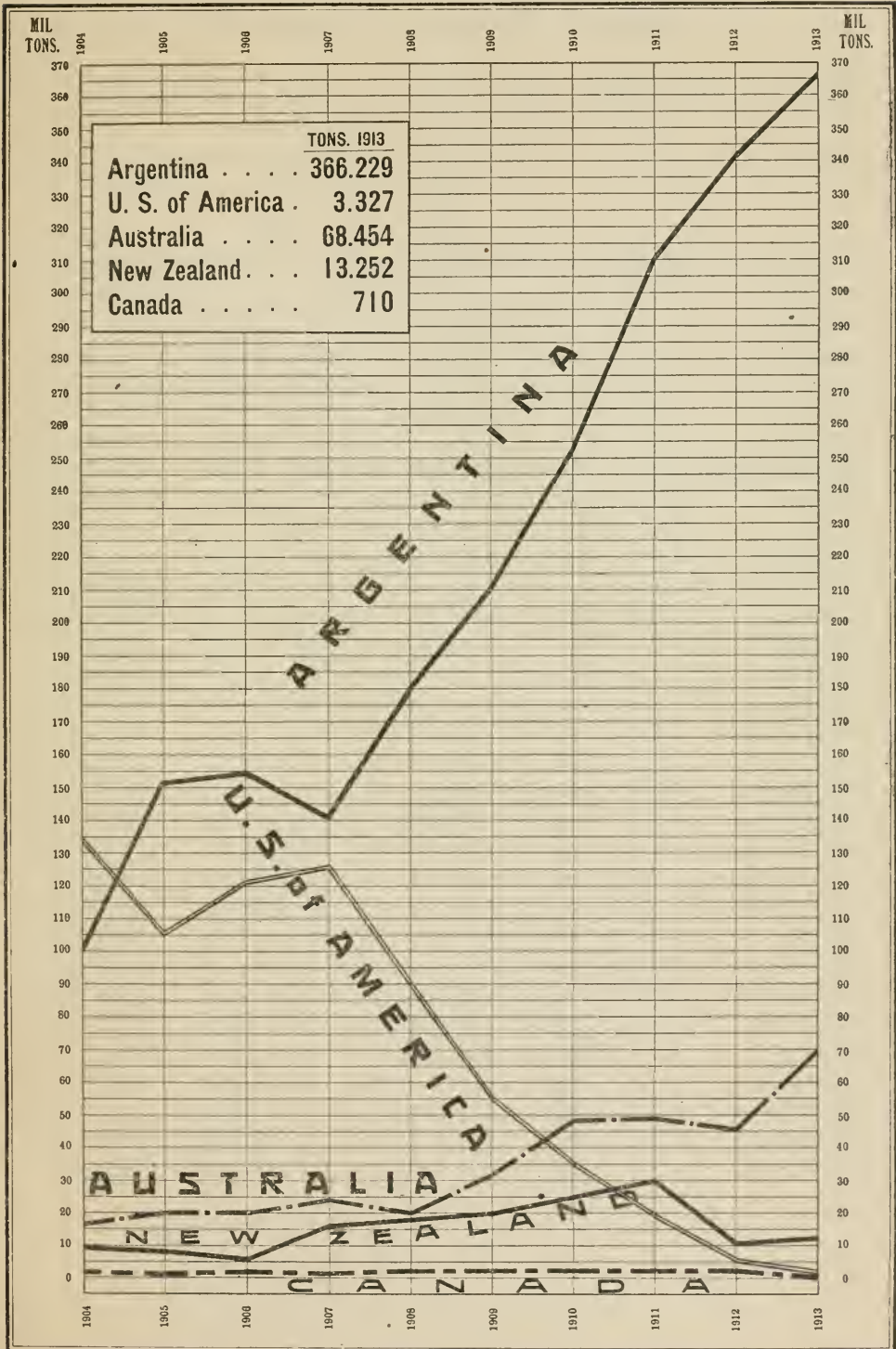

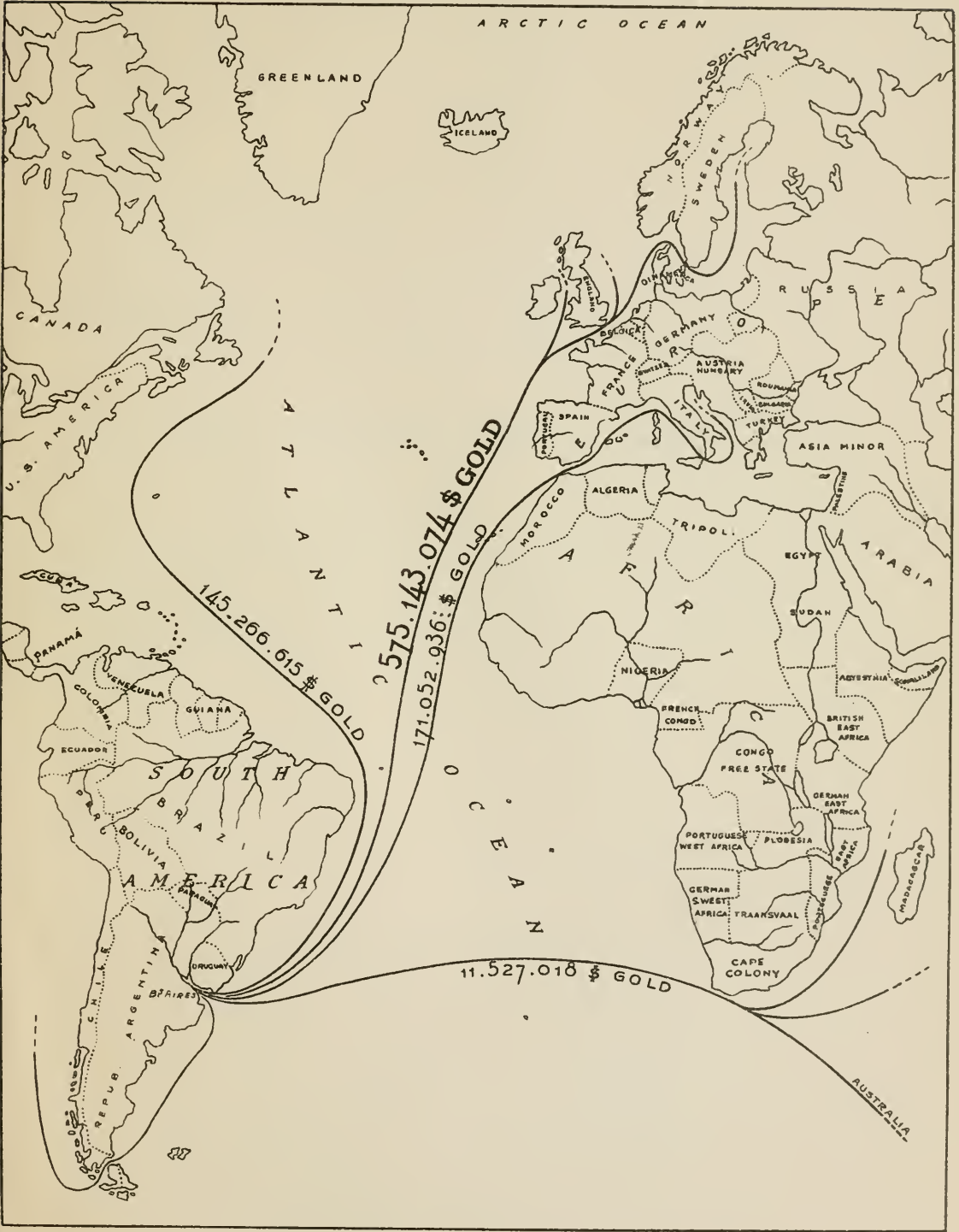
