Gallia, Massalia, \mathcal{A} , Drachm, Head of Artemis to right, with bow and quiver, *rev.* ΜΑΣΣΑΛΙΗΤΩΝ., Lion to right, in front the letter A. Massalia Obolos (2), Head of Apollo, *rev.* Wheel with MA., *all fine* 4

2 Italia, Romano Campanian Didrachms, &c. (4), Head of Mars helmeted to left, behind a branch of oak with acorn, *rev.* ROMANO., Horse's Head bridled, with wheat-ear behind (*Bab.* 4). ROMANO., Head of Apollo to left, *rev.* Freehorse going to right, star above (*Bab.* 6); young Head of Hercules wearing fillet and lion's skin, club on shoulder, *rev.* ROMANO. in exergue, the wolf suckling Romulus and Remus (*Bab.* 8), *fine*; Head of laureate beardless Janus, *rev.* ROMA. (in relief) on tablet, *rev.* Zeus in quadriga driven by Victory (*Bab.* 24), *fine* 4

- 3 Romano Campanian, \mathcal{A} , Didrachms, &c. (3), Head of Roma in Phrygian helmet to right, crescent behind, *rev.* ROMANO., *rev.* semi-draped figure of Victory to right, who is attaching a laurel wreath to a branch of palm, in field P.P. (*Bab.* 7), *fine*; another, similar. Laureate head of Apollo, hair long, to right, *rev.* ROMA., Free horse galloping to left (*Bab.* 37), *fine* 3
- 4 Cumæ, \mathcal{A} , Didrachms (2) Female Head, diademed to right, *rev.* NOIAMYX., Skylla, with two dogs to right, holding uncertain object with left hand, below mussel shell (*compare Carelli, pl. LXXI, n. 27*), *in fair condition and very rare.* Female Head to right, *rev.* KVM. Mussel shell and corn grain, *fine* 2
- 5 Neapolis, \mathcal{A} , Didrachms (6), B.C. 340-268, Head of Water Nymph, wearing diadem, earring and necklace, *rev.* Human headed bull, with Victory above, various symbols, Artemis holding two long lighted torches, grapes, &c., (two specimens have dolphins around head) 6
- 6 Hyria, \mathcal{A} , Didrachm, B.C. 420-340, Head of Pallas in round Athenian helmet, adorned with olive wreath and owl, *rev.* YPINAI., Campanian bull to left. Nola, \mathcal{A} , Didrachms (2), Female Head to right, with broad fillet, *rev.* NOΛAIΩN. in exergue, Campanian bull crowned by Victory. Head of Pallas in round Athenian helmet, adorned with olive branch and owl, *rev.* NOΛAIΩN., Campanian bull to right. Phistelia, \mathcal{A} , obol., young Head facing, *rev.* Oscan legend, mussel, corn grain and dolphin, *very fine* 4
- 7 Tarentum, \mathcal{A} , Didrachm of thick dumpy fabric, *circa* B.C. 520, TAPAΣ., Taras on dolphin to right, left arm extended beneath escallop shell, the whole within dotted border, *rev.* Wheel of four spokes (*Carelli, 50*), *fine*; another, *circa* B.C. 500, Taras on dolphin, *rev.* Sea horse with curled wings, escallop shell beneath, radiate border; and a third specimen, B.C. 420-380, Taras on dolphin to right, striking downwards with spear, *rev.* Horseman to left, with small round shield (*Evans, pl. Taras on dolphin holding Victory, with wreath and circular shield, and two javelins, beneath waves, in field ΓY ., *rev.* two Dioskuri to left, in field mon. , and below the horses $\Sigma\text{A}\Lambda\Omega\text{NO}\Sigma$. (*Evans*, VII, D. 1, *pl.* VIII, 9), *fine*. Taras on dolphin to right, holding in one hand a bow, and in the other hand an arrow, in field ΔI . and an elephant, *rev.* Naked Boy on horse walking to right, which is received and crowned by male figure, in field ΓY . and below $\text{A}\Pi\text{I}\Sigma\text{T}\text{I}\Gamma$. (*Evans*, VII, B. 1, *pl.* VIII, 4) 4
- 10 Tarentum, \mathcal{R} , Didrachms (4), TAPAS ., Taras on dolphin to left, holding akrostolion and distaff, in field $\text{AN}\Theta$., *rev.* Naked boy on horseback crowning himself, in field IA ., beneath horse $\text{I}\Lambda\Lambda\text{O}$., and capital of Ionic column (*Evans*, VII, C. 1). $\text{TAPA}\Sigma$., Taras on dolphin holding Kantharos and trident, in field $\text{A}\Gamma$., *rev.* Boy rider crowning horse going to left, in field NK ., beneath horse

- ΦΙΛΟΚΡΑ. (*Evans*, VIII, A. 6). ΤΑΡΑΣ., Taras seated on dolphin, holding Kantharos, *rev.* Naked boy rider crowning his steed, in field to left AP. (mon.) beneath horse bearded mask, and under fore leg ΚΥΝΩΝ. (*Evans*, VIII, B. 4, *Carelli*, CXII, 162), *fine.* ΤΑΡΑΣ., Taras on dolphin holding trident and cornucopiæ, in field a spike of corn, *rev.* Nude boy rider crowning his steed, in field ΕΥ., in front of horse ΦΙ., and beneath ΞΕΝΕΑΣ. (*Evans*, VIII, C. 1) 4
- 11 Tarentum, Ἀ, Didrachms (3), ΤΑΡΑΣ., Taras on dolphin, holding trident and tripod, in field bucranium, *rev.* Boy rider on stationary horse, holding reins, in front Ι. and beneath ΦΙΑΗΜΕΝΟΣ. (*Evans*, VIII, E. 1, *pl.* IX, 7). Campano Tarentum, Female Head to left, wearing diadem and earring, *rev.* Nude boy rider crowning his steed, in field to left dolphin, below a lion, and between horse's legs ΤΑ. (*Carelli*, CVIII, 92, *var.*), Female Head to left, *rev.* Nude boy rider crowning his steed, above ΤΑ., below a dolphin (*Evans*, V, *pl.* XI, 10), *fine* 3
- 12 Tarentum, Ἀ, Drachm, Head of Pallas, wearing crested helmet, decorated with Scylla, *rev.* ΤΑΡ., Owl on olive spray; another, varied, *both fine* (*see Evans*, page 126). Tarentum, Diobol, Head of Pallas, decorated with griffin, *rev.* ΤΑΡ. . . . Hercules strangling lion, *fine.* Tarentum, Obol, *obv.* and *rev.* Kantharos, &c. 5
- 13 Heraclea (Lucaniæ), Ἀ, Didrachm, helmeted Head of Pallas, *rev.* Hercules standing with club, bow and lion's skin. Heraclea (Lucaniæ), Ἀ, Diobol, Head of Pallas wearing crested helmet, decorated with Scylla, *rev.* Hercules strangling lion. Metapontum, Ἀ, Stater, B.C. 550-480, ΜΕΤ., ear of corn within circle of small dots, surrounded by border of large dots, *rev.* incuse, *fine.* Metapontum, Ἀ, Diobols (2), Head of Pallas in plain Corinthian helmet, *rev.* ΜΕΤΑ., ear of corn 5
- 14 Metapontum, Ἀ, Stater, B.C. 400-350, youthful male Head with ram's horn and ear to right of very fine style, *rev.* ΜΕΤΑ., ear of corn with leaf to left, *scarce.* Metapontum, Ἀ, Stater, 350-330, ΛΕΥΚΙΠΠΙΟΣ., Head of

- Leukippos, wearing plain Corinthian helmet to right, behind a dog seated, below Σ ., *rev.* META., ear of barley with leaf, on which a dove, *fine* 2
- 15 Metapontum, \mathcal{R} , Stater, B.C. 430-350, Female Head to left, wearing diadem, which appears only in front, hair turned up and rolled at back, waved at sides, earring and necklace, the whole within plain border, *rev.* METV., ear of barley, with leaf to left, above which small one-handled vase, *in fine condition and of very fine style (comp. B. M. cat, Italy, no. 72, p. 247), rare* 1
- 16 Metapontum, \mathcal{R} , Stater, B.C. 400-350, Female Head to right, the hair in knot behind, bound by double fillet crossed, wearing earring and plain necklet; the whole within a wreath of laurel, *rev.* ME., ear of barley, *in fine condition and of fine style, rare* 1
- 17 Metapontum, \mathcal{R} , Staters, B.C. 400-350, Head of Demeter to right, the hair rolled, *rev.* Ear of barley, cicada to right; Head of Persephone to right, hair bound with barley wreath, and wearing necklace, METV., Ear of barley, with leaf to left, *fine style*; Head of Persephone to left, wearing corn wreath and earring, *rev.* META., Ear of barley, with leaf to left, in field ΛA . and a rake, *fine* 3
- 18 Metapontum, \mathcal{R} , Staters (2), Head of Leukippos in plain Corinthian helmet to right, behind lion's head in profile, *rev.* META., Ear of barley, with leaf to left, on which an upright club, beneath AMI., *fine*; Head of Persephone in high relief, wearing wreath of barley, long earring and necklet, the hair turned up and rolled behind, *rev.* META., Ear of barley, with leaf to right, to left in field upright caduceus and ΛY . 2

- 20 Posidonia, \mathcal{R} , Drachm, B.C. 550-480, $\Pi O M$., Poseidon standing, looking to right, about to hurl trident, *rev.* the same type incuse, with exception of the legend;

- Staters (2), B.C. 480-400, ΠΟΣΕΙ., Poseidon to right, about to hurl trident, *rev.* ΠΟΜΕΣΔΑ., retrograde bull to left, on beaded exergual line, between two plain lines, beneath bull escalloped shell. ΠΟΣΕΙΔV., Poseidon, in field a dolphin, *rev.* ΠΟΣΙΔΑΝ., small bull to right on beaded line, above plain exergual line to right, *fine* 3

- 23 Thurium, \mathcal{A} , Distater, B.C. 390-350, Head of Pallas to right, in crested helmet, behind Δ., *rev.* ΘΟΥΠΙΩΝ., Bull butting to right, in exergue a fish, *fine* 1
- 24 Thurium, \mathcal{A} , Staters (3), B.C. 420-390, Head of Pallas to right, in crested helmet, bound with olive wreath, *rev.* ΘΟΥΠΙΩΝ., Bull to right, on dotted exergual line, beneath a fish; B.C. 390-350, Head of Pallas in crested helmet, decorated with Scylla to right, *rev.* ΘΟΥΠΙΩΝ., Bull butting to right, in exergue a fish, *fine* 3
- 25 Velia, \mathcal{A} , Didrachms (2), B.C. 400-268, Head of Pallas to left, in Phrygian helmet, decorated with female centaur, the flap plain, in field behind neck KE. (*mon.*), *rev.* ΥΕΛΗΤΩΝ., in exergue lion devouring prey (*B. M. C.* IV, c. 24), Head of Pallas in Phrygian helmet, with griffin, the flap ornamented, behind Θ., *rev.* ΥΕΛΗΤΩΝ., lion devouring prey to right, above cicada between Φ— 1, *both fine*; and a Drachm, B.C. 540-500, forepart of lion devouring prey, *rev.* Incuse square 3
- 26 Velia, \mathcal{A} , Staters (3), B.C. 400-268, Head of Pallas in crested Athenian helmet, ornamented with wing to left, behind neck K., *rev.* ΥΕΛΗΤΩΝ., in exergue lion walking to left, above triskelis, between Φ— 1; Head of Pallas similar to last, but to right behind neck Δ., and in front signature Φ., *rev.* ΥΕΛΗΤΩΝ., lion walking to

- right, above ear of barley, between Φ — 1 ; Head of Pallas to left, in crested helmet, ornamented with griffin, behind neck I.E. in indented square, *rev.* Lion pulling down stag, *all fine* 3
- 27 Croton, \mathcal{R} , Stater, B.C. 550-480, $\varphi\varrho\omicron$., Tripod, crab to right, *rev.* Tripod incuse, the crab and legend in relief, *fine* 1
- 28 Caulonia, \mathcal{R} , Stater, B.C. 550-480, $\text{KAY}\Lambda$., Naked Archaic male figure advancing to right, on outstretched arm small running figure, in field to right a stag, the whole type within dotted cable border, *rev.* the same type incuse, but the small running figure and legend are not depicted, *fine* 1
- 29 Caulonia, \mathcal{R} , Stater, similar to last, *but not so fine* ; Stater, *circa* 480, KAV ., nude figure advancing to right, with small running figure on outstretched arm, in field a stag, *rev.* Stag standing to right 2
- 30 Caulonia, \mathcal{R} , Staters (2) $\text{KV}\Lambda\Lambda$., Nude male figure, similar to the pieces described last in preceding lot, *rev.* $\text{KAV}\Lambda$., retrograde, a stag standing to right, in front a tree ; Stater, \mathcal{R} , B.C. 480-388, Nude male figure to right, sacrificial fillet over arm, *rev.* $\text{KAY}\Lambda\Omega\text{NITAS}$., Stag to right ; Third of Stater, $\text{KAV}\Lambda$., Nude figure with branch, in field a stag, *rev.* $\text{KAV}\Lambda$., stag to right, tree in front 3

- 32 Croton, \mathcal{R} , Stater, *circa* B.C. 390, $\text{KPOT}\Omega\text{NIATAS}$., Head of Apollo, laureated with flowing hair, *rev.* the Infant Herakles strangling two serpents, *a most pleasing coin, see Gardner, "Types of Greek Coins," pl. v, 16-10, rare* 1
- 33 Croton, \mathcal{R} , Stater, B.C. 370-330, laureated Head of Apollo, hair long to right, *rev.* KPO ., Tripod, branch to right, *fine* ; Stater, \mathcal{R} , Eagle on olive branch to left, with spread wings, *rev.* KPO ., Tripod, with pendant fillet to right and the letter Δ . 2

- 34 Locri Epizephyrii, \mathcal{A} , Stater, $\Lambda\text{OKP}\Omega\text{N.}$, Head of Zeus to left, with flowing hair, *rev.* Eagle devouring hare, in field fulmen, *fine*; Corinthian Stater, \mathcal{A} , *circa* B.C. 344-332, *weight* 135 *grs.*, $\Lambda\text{OKP}\Omega\text{N.}$, Head of Pallas to left, in Corinthian helmet, *rev.* Pegasos to left, in field fulmen, *fine* 2
- 35 Rhegium, \mathcal{A} , Drachm, $\text{C}\text{Eginetic}$, Lion scalp facing, border of dots, *rev.* PECION. , retrograde, Calf's head to left. Bruttium, \mathcal{A} , Stater, B.C. 282-203, Head of winged Nike, *rev.* $\text{BPETT}\text{I}\Omega\text{N.}$, Nude male figure crowning himself, *fine* 2
- 36 Terina, \mathcal{A} , Stater, B.C. 470-440, Head of the Nymph Terina, the hair turned up at back and rolled, the whole within wreath of olive, *rev.* Winged Nike seated to left on four-legged stool, holding with extended right hand a wreath, and in left hand caduceus, *fine*; Stater, \mathcal{A} , B.C. 440-400, Head of the Nymph Terina, wearing ampyx, &c. (*as Head, Hist. Num. fig. 65*), within wreath of olive, *rev.* $\text{TEPINA}\text{I}\Omega\text{N.}$, Winged figure seated on cippus, holding caduceus downwards 2
- 37 Terina, \mathcal{A} , Stater, B.C. 440-400, $\text{TEPINA}\text{I}\Omega\text{N.}$, Head of the Nymph Terina to right, the hair rolled, wearing earring and necklace, *rev.* Winged female figure seated on square cippus, upon which her left hand rests, and supporting on back of right hand a little bird (*Head, Hist. Num. page 97, fig. 66*), *very fine, a scarce and desirable piece* 1
- 38 Terina, \mathcal{A} , Stater, TE-PINIAI. , Female Head to left, wearing sphenone hair in korymbos, *rev.* Winged figure seated on square cippus, holding caduceus; Stater, \mathcal{A} , Female Head to right, hair rolled, the whole within wreath of olive, *rev.* Winged figure seated on four-legged stool, holding wreath; Thirds of Staters (2), $\text{TEPINA}\text{I}\Omega\text{N.}$, Head of the Nymph Terina to right, behind triskelis, *rev.* Winged female seated on square cippus, holding bird on right hand, in field TE. (*mon.*); another, similar, but the head is to left, and on *rev.* a star in field; Sixths of Staters (2), similar types, &c. 7

- 39 Sicilia, Agrigentum, \mathcal{A} , Tetradrachm, B.C. 477-415, AKPACANTOΣ., Eagle with closed wings, standing on the capital of a column, to left, *rev.* Crab, beneath a large eight pointed star 1
