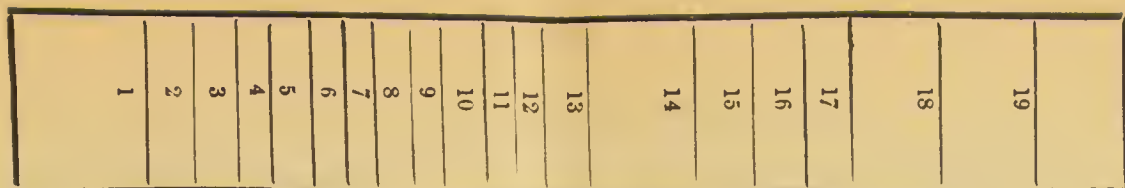

CONDITIONS OF SALE.
