These medals are excessively rare, but three originals were struck (1 B, I C, I W M); the one in copper is in the cabinet of Wm. S. Ap pleton, Esq., the one in brass was in the Mickley collection, and sold for \$42.50 to Colonel Bushnell; at the Bushnell sale it brought \$43; I resurrected the original dies at the "Old Curiosity Shop," in Baltimore, in 1882, and in the presence of members of the Baltimore Numismatic Society, had struck 1 gold and 21 each in silver, brass and copper; the dies were destroyed on the spot, and presented to the society; sworn certificates to that effect accompanied each medal or set. They were mostly subscribed for in advance, at \$5 for silver and \$2,50 each for brass and copper, the few left were quickly disposed of; this set was bought at the time, but with the ups and downs of life must go with the balance of the collection, as the political hatchet is awaiting the owner's scalp. 
